

#### ...even if you paid me.

It hasn't got anything to do with my "man card", in fact, on the bottom of my man card, it specifically states that "you can hold this card with pride even if you don't want anything to do with the movie 'IT'". lol Now I'm not destroying horror movie buffs, that's your thing, it just isn't mine, but if something gets me that scared, either me or that thing is ending right there. To tweak a quote from one of my favorite cult classics "There WILL be only one."

I posted that sentiment on Facebook, and it surprised me. I was expecting to take it on the chin for being a wimp, but it elicited a lot of responses that were in agreement, from a lot of guys, and one interesting quote that made me think...not what I expected from a post I'm just messing with people about. The quote was from John Piper, a famous theologian/pastor, who says that horror movies are kind of like "fear pornography" and his thought line is that we are using an emotion in a way that it wasn't intended to be used.

I see that, because God created fear, just like anything else, to be an active part of our lives to help us in the course of our lives...not just something we manufacture or manipulate to get a rush for entertainment's sake.


One of the primary reasons for "fear" is that we should fear the Lord, but that's not how people use fear most of the time. It doesn't mean that we are simply to be scared of God. I mean, we'll be scared of Him, just like we have an unsettled feeling when we are in the presence of something

(or someone) who's far larger or more powerful or who has a lot of influence...but He doesn't desire for the sole goal of the man to God relationship to be scared to death of Him.

Proverbs 9:10 says "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and knowledge of the Holy One is understanding." "Fear of the Lord" is in the sense of priority. Who is the first person that you consider in EVERYTHING? Who's the last person you want to disappoint? When you put God in that level one position, you begin to have wisdom (to know what to do), and as you learn more about God (knowledge), you gain understanding (to know why you do it). It's very common to begin a walk with Christ going "what in the world does God want me to do this?", but because God is in the number one priority in your life, you do it. Eventually, you begin to see the reasons why as you go through

So, whether you are using your fear to scream at a crazy clown in a sewer, or for self-preservation in a life-threatening situation, remember that the most valuable use, the greatest use isn't entertainment or even survival. It's gaining an understanding of the world and knowing what and how you are supposed to interact in it to secure your eternity...and I'm still not watching "IT".

#### Dear Val,

In the last issue of Spotlight, you stated that Scientology is a cult. I'm not disagreeing with you but with all the different religions, what makes one a cult and another legitimate? I've always associated cults with those practicing satanic or pagan rituals.

#### Dear Barry,

Not all cults are as obvious as one would expect. From a Christian standpoint, a cult is any religious group that denies or distorts biblical truths thereby causing a person to remain unsaved if he or she believes it. Imagine filling a salt shaker with 90% salt and 10% sand. The entire mixture is contaminated and rendered useless.

The Bible teaches that we are saved by faith alone—through Christ Jesus and yet two of the most common teachings of Christian-cults are that Jesus is not God and that we are saved by our own works. A denial of Jesus' deity means that His death was not a sufficient payment for our sins. The Bible emphatically states that we are not saved through works. It is written in Ephesians 2:8-9, "For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— not by works..."

#### Dear Val.

In the last five years, I've been mugged twice (once in New York and once in Orlando). I want to take classes in self defense—maybe study Tae Kwon Do or something. I'm sick and tired of being a victim. When I mentioned this during a luncheon, one of my friends told me Christians shouldn't study martial arts. Is this true? Aren't we allowed to defend ourselves?

#### Dear Patty,

I empathize with you. Growing up in Detroit, I used to feel like a magnet for stalkers and child molesters. I've been a second-degree black-belt for many years and I have benefited both from learning and teaching self-defense.

While the Bible has much to say about "turning the other cheek", there is also clear and concise doctrine regarding self-defense. Christians are allowed to defend themselves as Jesus illustrated in Luke 22:36. He said to the disciples, "...and if you don't have a sword, sell your cloak and buy one..." and also in Exodus 22:2-3 it is written, "If a thief is caught breaking in and is struck so that he dies, the defender is not guilty of bloodshed..." This scripture does not refer to private justice for thievery but for defending your life against an attacker.

There are many benefits obtained through studying martial arts such as: learning self-defense, improved cardio-vascular, stretching exercises, and the smooth and fluid movements of Tai Chi (especially for the elderly).

Now for the bad news...The majority of martial art schools integrate Buddhist and Zen philosophies throughout their training and that's where we, as Christians, fall in disagreement. When I studied martial arts, I was not a mature Christian and I didn't know of the possible dangers. Fortunately, several of my instructors were Christ followers and I was not taught conflicting principles. By doing a little research and asking the right questions, you may find suitable training in self-defense but before you make a decision, ask God for discernment and wisdom.


# Countess Athena & Godfather's Twins

The four sets of twins, Danny and Antonio was born in 1982; Mary and Janella were born in 1983; Sophia and Marie were born in 1984; and fraternal twins, Celilia, known as CC, and Bartholemew, known as the Tank, was born in 1989. All the older girls are 5'6" to 5'8" tall, 120-130ibs. All of the girls resemble their great-grandmother, Countess Athena. The older twins brothers are 6'2" and 185lbs. with no known pictures. The older generation would have all passed away by now, but the twins and staff could be still alive somewhere. Someone, somewhere in the world must know what happened!

to keep us safe. There are also so many humanitarians that did all they could to help save a life, or just helped a friend or a fellow American in need during these trying times.

Life after a natural disaster and that of a major hurricane can be challenging. The stress from the preparation and

the decision to stay or evacuate can be very frustrating, not to mention the unknowns leading up to the Irma's impact: not knowing until a few days prior where the storm will actually hit and how strong it will be when it does. That being said there are some big questions. What will things be

like after the storm? Will you have damage? How long will you be without power? The list goes on, hence the reason why preparation and planning are very important factors when a major hurricane is on the horizon.

The next concern is if your area is severely damaged, how does one relocate to a safe home until repairs can be made and how long will one be without work? In

> the real estate world there are so many variables. One of the main concerns is once an area or county is considered a natural disaster area are the sale and purchases of homes. Is the home I was going to purchase damaged or will the storm effect my property value even if it was not damaged? Irma has without a doubt affected the sale of homes causing more caution and movement in the market to be at a slower pace. It also causes a shortage in rental properties available. This, of course, even effected many transactions that may already be under contract and quite possibly may have already been through the inspection time period and the appraisal before

the hurricane. That being said, after a major hurricaneand especially if your county has been declared a natural disaster area- then it is likely that at minimum the lender will require the property to be re-inspected by an appraiser. Having a trained professional with current knowledge of the new regulations will be essential to navigating this difficult time.



#### HELP SENIOR DRIVERS

#### **Maintain Their Independence**

As men and women age, various factors may affect their ability to drive. In addition to issues

**drive.** In addition to issues with memory, seniors may have failing eyesight and physical limitations, and their reaction time may slow down. In such



instances, seniors' ability to safely operate a motor vehicle may be questioned.

Age alone is not a reliable measure of driving ability, but many of the issues that affect one's ability to safely drive a vehicle tend to appear as men and women near their golden years.

Losing the ability to safely operate an automobile can greatly reduce a person's independence. That is why periodic driver evaluations may be met with some reluctance. Aging men and women who don't want to avoid potential conflicts with concerned family members can take their own steps to ensure they maintain their ability to safely operate a motor vehicle.

#### Schedule a driving safety evaluation

When drivers' abilities to operate a motor vehicle become suspect, a thorough evaluation should be scheduled. The evaluation should not be handled by a family physician or family member, but by an unbiased third party like a Certified Driving Rehabilitation Specialist. This is a therapist who has special certification to assist people with disabilities, including older adults, with driving. They can help individuals with adaptive equipment or techniques if driving issues stem from something that can be addressed.

#### Figure out if the car "fits" the individual

A program called CarFit can help drivers assess if their car is suited to their abilities. A team of trained technicians and/or health professionals work with participants to ensure their vehicles are equipped for maximum safety and comfort. A properly adjusted vehicle is as important as one's cognitive and physical abilities. Adjustments can include mirror placement, good foot positioning and sitting at the proper distance from the steering wheel. People can learn about an upcoming event at www.car-fit. org.

#### Take a driver improvement course

Driver improvement courses are provided by various organizations, including some insurance companies. AARP also has a Driver Safety Course to lower the risk of traffic violations, collisions and injuries. Completion of these courses can help drivers enhance their abilities behind the wheel and may result in lower premiums for mature drivers.

#### Keep the mind and body fit

Regular exercise and a healthy diet can be assets for mature drivers. Mental fitness techniques and brain exercises can improve reaction time, while aerobic and strength-training workouts can keep the body in shape.

Driving is one of the key avenues to personal independence. Strengthening seniors' driving abilities is a goal of many organizations.





A healthy spine is an often overlooked and essential part of a healthy lifestyle. People who suffer from back pain, particularly if it is long-term, are generally less healthy than those who do not. In fact, back pain costs are staggering not only financially, but also in terms of lost time from work and because of psychosocial problems that arise during the healing process associated with long-term back pain.

Unfortunately, approximately 80-90% of the population suffers from spinal pain at some point. People who are overweight or obese, and who smoke, lift heavy objects, or had a previous episode of back pain, are more likely to experience back pain.

Because so many people suffer from spine pain, it's important for you to try to keep your spine as healthy as possible. Following simple posture, lifting, and healthy lifestyle guidelines can help you keep your back in good shape.

#### **Standing**

When standing, keep one foot slightly in front of the other, with your knees slightly bent. This position helps to take the pressure off your low back. Do not stand bent forward at the waist for prolonged periods of time. The muscles in your low back become deconditioned in this position, which may lead to pain.

#### Lifting

At all times, avoid twisting while lifting. Twisting is one of the most dangerous movements for your spine, especially while lifting. If the item is too heavy to lift, pushing it is easier on your back than pulling it. Whenever possible, use your legs, not your back or upper body, to push the item. If you must lift a heavy item, get someone to help you.

#### **Sitting**

Keep your knees slightly higher than your hips, with your head up and back straight. Avoid rolling your shoulders forward (slouching). Try to maintain the natural curve in your low back.

#### **Reaching and Bending**

When reaching for something above shoulder level, stand on a stool. Straining to reach such objects may not only hurt your mid-back and neck, but it can also bring on shoulder problems. Do NOT bend over at the waist to pick up items from the floor or a table. Instead, kneel down on one knee, as close as possible to the item you are lifting, with the other foot flat on the floor and pick the item up. Or bend at the knees, keep the item close to your body, and lift with your leas, not your back.

#### Carrying

When carrying objects, particularly if they are heavy, keep them as close to your body as possible. Carrying two small objects—one in each hand—is often easier to handle than one large one.

#### **Healthy Diet and Exercise**

While the proverbial jury is still out, we suspect that extra weight puts undue strain on your spine. Keep within 10 lbs. of your ideal weight for a healthier back. "Beer belly" is likely the worst culprit, as it puts unwanted pressure on the muscles, ligaments and tendons in your low back. The most efficient and effective way to reduce weight is by eating a sensible diet and exercising regularly. Consult with your doctor before beginning any exercise program, particularly if you have a health condition.

Placing a pillow under your knees while lying on your back cuts the pressure on your spine roughly in half. Lying on your side with a pillow between your knees may also reduce the pressure on your back.

Never sleep in a position that causes a portion of your spine to hurt. Most often, your body will tell you what position is best.







#### **HOW TO MANAGE YOUR PASSWORDS**

#### SPOTLIGHT ON COMPUTING

Passwords are a daily source of frustration for all of us, because so much of our lives are tied up in the online world. As everyone should know by now, using weak passwords, especially the same weak password on all your accounts, is a really bad idea.

#### How Does a Password Manager Work?

All password managers work in the same general way: They provide you with a secure 'locker' that contains all of your passwords, which are protected by one master password. These lockers incorporate very high levels of encryption, so even if someone were to gain access to one, it would take an extraordinary effort to crack the locker.

A Password Manager also provide a way to generate a different long complex password for each of your online accounts, so you don't have to come up with all of them yourself.

#### Where The Locker Lives

The location of the password

'locker' determines both security and convenience, so understanding the difference will help you understand which approach makes the most sense for you. From a security standpoint, if the encrypted locker lives on your own machine, you'll never have to worry about whether a third-party service company gets hacked.

One of the more popular free tools that will store your password database locally is KeePass (http://keepass.info). The downside to this open-source tool is that it requires a lot more manual configuration and could become confusing for non-technical users.

Another minor inconvenience is that if you want to use KeePass on a computer that you don't own, you'll either have to sync your database to an online storage service or store it on a flash drive that you have to carry around. Security fanatics like this approach because they get to control all of the aspects of the security.

A popular free option that stores your



encrypted locker online is LastPass (http://lastpass.com). The advantage of storing the encrypted file on their servers is that you aren't beholden to a single computer or required to carry a separate device around for authentication. You simply install it on all of your devices – desktop, laptop, smartphone or tablet which are synced up – or log in through their website if you're on a device you don't own.

On its face, storing all your passwords on the Internet may seem scary, but the reality is that these companies are going to be much better at securing the locker than most users. Even if the company gets breached, the stolen information would have to be decrypted, which would take a bit of time. A simple reset of your master password and saved passwords would render the stolen information useless. On the other hand, if your personal computer gets breached, you may never know it happened.

#### Free vs Paid

The competition in the password manager world is pretty fierce, so many of the more popular options have gone to a 'freemium' model. This means that they provide a basic level of service for free and offer premium features that vary for each program for a fee. The security level is exactly the same, so you'll be paying for the extra features only if you want them.



# FAST Action Saves Sight

Retinal Detachments: What you don't know could cost you your vision.


qualities such as color and light-intensity. That information is sent through the optic nerve from the retina to the brain, which creates the images we see.

Retinal detachment occurs when the retina pulls away from its normal position

and is cut off from nourishing blood vessels. The interior of the retina also can be harmed by the appearance of tears or holes, conditions that may progress when left untreated.

Dr. Ganiban emphasizes that whether the retina is affected by a small tear or full detachment, the injury can occur suddenly and without warning. "There is no pain or redness of the eve associated with these conditions," notes the doctor.

"However, in many cases, there are warning signs, and these signs should not be ignored," adds Dr. Ganiban. Patients with retinal detachments may experience sudden changes in their field of vision. They may notice an increased number of tiny specks called floaters, which may seem like moving cobwebs, strings or strands.Some have described what looks like a curtain coming down

incoming light and vision becomes blurred and dim.

over a portion of their vision.

These symptoms can occur before the retina fully detaches, explains Hetal D. Vaishnav, MD, director of clinical research and preventive medicine at The Eve Institute for Medicine & Surgery.

This is when time will be critical.

"If a patient or referring doctor suspects a retinal detachment, a key to heling ensure that vision is maintained or regained is to schedule an examination with a retinal specialist as soon as possible," advises Dr. Vaishnav.

"The bottom line is that in many cases, a thorough, dilated eve examination will reveal the retinal hole or tear prior to it developing into a full detachment.

"Then a procedure can be performed through a laser or freezing probe to seal the tear and help prevent any further separation of the retina," assures Dr. Vaishnav.

very year, nearly 25,000 people in the United States experience retinal detachments, a true medical emergency that can threaten their sight. For some, symptoms begin gradually and may be barely noticeable. Others will experience a sudden and dramatic decrease in their vision, creating an obvious urgency to seek care. "There is no question that a retinal detachment left untreated can lead to vision loss that can become permanent in the absence of timely and expert care," states Gary J. Ganiban, MD, chief of vitreoretinal surgery at The Eve Institute for Medicine & Surgery. The retina is a thin, interior layer of

tissue at the back of the eye. Its job is to process light through special cells called photoreceptors that detect

#### Gentler repair procedure

A trend in retinal surgery to repair retinal detachments has been to move away from a treatment known as scleral buckle and toward a procedure called vitrectomy. A scleral buckle involves placement of a tiny device on the eye's outer surface that helps close the retinal break. Vitrectomy removes most of the vitreous, the clear, gel-like substance inside the eye.

Vitrectomy offers numerous advantages for most patients who

need surgery for retinal detachment, says Dr. Ganiban. One is that removing the vitreous reduces traction on the repaired retinal tear. This makes future retinal tears less likely.

The vitrectomy procedure frequently takes less time than other methods, which often means the risk of complications is reduced, he adds.

"Vitrectomy surgeries heal relatively rapidly due to minimal surgical trauma," states Dr. Ganiban. "Very little cutting is required, and frequently stitches aren't required. Compared to a scleral buckle, vitrectomy is very gentle.

"Another advantage of vitrectomy is that the shape of the eye isn't altered and therefore there shouldn't be a change in the patient's eyeglass prescription. With a scleral buckle, the eye may become elongated, causing induced myopia, which is nearsightedness, and/or a visually significant astigmatism."

#### The Ganihand for better view

A medical innovation developed on the Space Coast by Dr. Ganiban is now aiding eye surgeons during vitrectomy procedures. The surgeon's view of the back of the eye and affected structures is critical during retinal repairs. Traditionally, this enhanced view is achieved with the help of a surgical technician. The technician applies slight pressure to the sclera, the eye's outer, white surface, with a cotton tip applicator or scleral depressor made of stainless steel. The surgeon can then see the back of the eve through the patient's well-dilated pupil.

This method is decades-old but can be cumbersome and inefficient. In most cases, it increases the length of the surgery.

Dr. Ganiban knew there had to be a better way and designed a handsfree scleral depressor device. During surgery, the instrument is secured to the speculum that keeps the patient's eye propped open. It features a custom light pipe to ensure the surgeon has an ideal view of the interior eye without the need for a surgical assistant.

There are now multiple versions and sizes of the Ganihand in development to ensure the device will be suitable for all related surgical applications. "It is my sincere hope that my new instrument will help surgeons all over the United States and the world to improve their surgical outcomes, minimize complications and restore vision that otherwise may not have been regained," says Dr. Ganiban.

Jesus. The single most fearless act that ever was; He chose whips and nails over His comfort and convenience.


The call of duty for believers is both standard and defined.

### The Kids Can't Talk Behind My Back Anymore




