Serene Harbor has assisted over 25,000 individuals throughout our history via our direct intervention services and outreach programs. We have a single location in Brevard County providing shelter to female victims of domestic violence their children, and their beloved family pet. We work with men on an outreach basis due to the communal living arrangements at the shelter. Temporary emergency shelter for women and children is our primary function. Each survivor receives an individual case plan with goals they want to achieve while at our shelter. They discuss their needs with our Case Manager to determine their priorities and the Case Manager assists in facilitating progress towards the goals. We transport shelter residents to services they require throughout the County, including access to an Injunction for Protection attorney through the IFP Program*.

We also provide an individual case plan for each child that comes into the shelter with their mother. We want to ensure each child's needs are met and that we work with the children to break the cycle of violence. All our services are provided free of charge. Call our confidential 24hr hotline at (321) 726-8282 for information or assistance.

*This project was supported by VOCA-2016-Florida Coalition Against-00842 awarded by the Office of Victims of Crime, Office of Justice Programs. Sponsored by the Florida Coalition Against Domestic Violence-Legal Project (FCADV) and the State of Florida.

Shelter and Outreach Program staff provided 6,604 nights of shelter to 101 women, 89 children and 11 pets; Answered 963 hotline calls; Provided 431 face to face safety plans; outreach services to 63 women and 3 men and assisted 101 individuals in obtaining alternative shelter because we were at capacity when they requested assistance.

The CPI program's DVCW Advocate provided support on over 400 cases involving 662 minor children. In the past 6 months the IFP Attorney provided legal services to 110 individuals including 8 men.

Our Primary Prevention Facilitator provided 2 rounds of Healthy Relationships training to third grade students at Emma Jewel Charter School and Imagine Elementary. In addition to working with shelter children the Prevention Facilitator also provides monthly "Prevention Club" meetings with youth in the Diamond Square community.








DAY TRIPS: The Florida Keys

It's a little more than a day trip, as it is a long day trip just to make it to the edge of the keys at Key Largo but if you have never been to the keys, it's worth it. In fact, it is worth it just to drive there and then turn around and drive back. Though it would be a lot more fun to stay the day and come back a couple of days.

If you think you live in Florida's paradise, the Florida keys is the Hawaii area. Over 100 miles of road linking the Miami

area to key west on the road US Hwy 1) that goes from upper most Maine at the Canada border to lower key west, southernmost USA. Folks line up there nightly to party and watch the sun go down. These sunset rituals have become a standard in the tropical paradise.

But you needn't travel all the way to the key west to catch the keys disease. Starting at Key Largo flora and fauna abound, and though the traffic may back up sometimes, there is plenty to look at. Side road excursions can take you to quaint shops with nautical themes, shell collections, and tropical plant nurseries. Rookeries of shorebirds, and many migratory bird species, as well as parrots and iguanas and key deer. Sunset cruises and nature study tours can show you everything. Kayaks and paddleboards and boats of all sizes dominate keys life.

Aquatic life is amazing with whales, sharks and tropic fish mix with manatees and other brackish water fish. A fantastic lobster season attracts many as does the fishing and seafood on every corner, fresh, cooked or frozen. Camping areas, rocky shores, and beaches line both coasts of the Atlantic Caribbean and the Gulf of Mexico Florida Bay.

Dolphin adventures? You can get right in the water with them. The 7-mile bridge tells you you are almost to key west, wait for it. There are more Key West events than can be mentioned here. Celebrities then and now flocked here. Hemingway, Truman, and Flagler, who brought the train trestle down the line of small islands known as the Florida Straits to promote his railroad and make Key West a more available port of call.

Music is loud and rowdy throughout the keys, OR soft and tropically romantic. History goes back to Henry Perrine and his massacre by the Calusas at Indian Key. A hurricane in the 20s roared through and killed or stranded thousands of residents and vacationers. Brutal weather mixed with temperate winters and tropical trade winds make for a comfortable lifestyle, not unlike Hawaii or Tahiti....

For a historical look at vintage Florida in its pure state, half Everglades - half palm beach or Miami- it's truly an amazing place. I always tell people if you haven't seen Alaska, Yellowstone or the Florida keys....do that before you travel abroad for sure!



DOES BACK PAIN GO AWAY ON ITS OWN?

SPOTLIGHT ON CHIROPRACTIC HEALTH

Eighty percent of people suffer from back pain at some point in their lives. Back pain is the second most common reason for visits to the doctor's office, outnumbered only by upper-respiratory infections. Most cases of back pain are mechanical or non-organic, ai.e., not caused by serious conditions, such as inflammatory arthritis, infection, fracture, or cancer.

What Causes Back Pain?

The back is a complicated structure of bones, joints, ligaments, and muscles. You can sprain ligaments, strain muscles, rupture disks, and irritate joints, all of which can lead to back pain. While sports injuries or accidents can cause back pain, sometimes the simplest of movements-for example, picking up a pencil from the floor-can have painful results. In addition, arthritis, poor posture, obesity, and psychological stress can cause or complicate back pain. Back pain can also directly result from disease of the internal organs, such as kidney stones, kidney infections, blood clots, or bone loss.

Back injuries are a part of everyday life, and the spine is quite good at dealing with these often "pulled" muscles. These

very minor injuries usually heal within 1 or 2 days. Some pain, however, continues. What makes some pain last longer is not entirely understood, but researchers suspect that the reasons may include stress, mood changes, and the fear of further injury that may prevent patients from being active. In addition, sometimes a painful injury or disease changes the way the pain signals are sent through the body, and, even after the problem has gone away or is inactive, the pain signals still reach the brain. It is as if the pain develops a memory that keeps being replayed.

Will Back Pain Go Away on Its Own?

Until recently, researchers believed that back pain will "heal" on its own. We have learned, however, that this is not true. A recent study showed that when back pain is not treated, it may go away temporarily but will most likely return. The study demonstrated that in more than 33% of the people who experience low-back pain, the pain lasts for more than 30 days. Only 9% of the people who had low-back pain for more than 30 days were pain free 5 years later.

Another study looked at all of the available research on the natural history of low-back pain. The results showed that when it is ignored, back pain does not go away on its own. Those studies demonstrate that low-back pain continues to affect people for long periods after it first begins.

What Can I Do to Prevent Long-Term Back Pain?

If your back pain is not resolving quickly, visit your doctor of chiropractic. Your pain will often result from mechanical problems that your doctor of chiropractic can address. Many chiropractic patients with relatively long-lasting or recurring back pain feel improvement shortly after starting chiropractic treatment. The relief they feel after a month of treatment is often greater than after seeing a family physician.

Chiropractic spinal manipulation is a safe and effective spine pain treatment. It reduces pain, decreases medication, rapidly advances physical therapy, and requires very few passive forms of treatment, such as bed rest.

How Can I Prevent Back Pain?

Don't lift by bending over. Instead, bend your hips and knees and then squat to pick up the object. Keep your back straight, and hold the object close to your body.

Don't twist your body while lifting.

Push, rather than pull, when you must move heavy objects.

If you must sit for long periods, take frequent breaks and stretch.

Wear flat shoes or shoes with low heels.

Exercise regularly. An inactive lifestyle contributes to lower-back pain.







STEPS TO TAKE BEFORE DITCHING YOUR PRINTER

SPOTLIGHT ON COMPUTING

Most of us are very aware of the dangers of disposing of our computers,

smartphones, and tablets without first

wiping them clean
of our personal
information, pictures,
and files but not
so much with our
printers. Depending
upon the type of
printer you have,
you may very well
have to take steps
to ensure that your
private information
isn't still being stored
in the device's internal memory.



What's At Risk?

It may not be that obvious, but your printer/fax/scanner can potentially be storing some of the most sensitive information that you have ever printed, scanned, faxed or copied. Everything from tax returns to medical forms to insurance documents have likely passed through your printer over its life. More sophisticated network printers

that can e-mail documents directly can also be storing sensitive e-mail server configuration and passwords that you'll

want to wipe out.

Consumer Printers

Most consumer grade printers have very little storage memory and it's generally considered 'volatile memory,' which means that when the power

is turned off whatever it was storing is gone. If your printer has no fax or copier functions, it most likely won't have any type of persistent memory storage that needs to be reset, but just to be sure, check your printer's 'Settings' menu for any options that allow you to reset the device to the factory defaults.

If you ever get a message during the reset process warning you that all your data will be lost, you'll know that it was

storing personal information. If your device has memory card slots for things like camera cards, don't forget to check to see if you've left any old cards in there.

Networked Multifunction Printers

While most consumers aren't likely to have printers with internal storage, virtually every business grade copier/printer/fax device is highly likely to be storing a large amount of sensitive information on a persistent storage device. If your company printer has the ability to receive faxes and route them via e-mail to the proper recipient, it first has to store the incoming faxes in some form of internal memory.

If your device can store addresses for sending scanned documents, you should assume that it can store more than just addresses. Private printing, which refers to the ability for a printer to hold a print job until you are physically in front of the printer and type in a code, certainly points to an internal storage device. The ability to re-order print jobs that are in the queue is another indication of internal memory capabilities.

Protection Suggestions

Most of today's printers that include large internal storage devices also include secure wipe options in their settings. If you can't find the reset instructions for your printer, a simple Internet search that includes your exact make and model with the word reset after it should yield the directions. If you can't find any info from a general search, try checking at http://resetprinters.com and if you can't find anything there, you probably have nothing to worry about.



Health First Holmes Regional Medical Center Debuts Hybrid Operating Room (OR)

Health First is welcoming a new era of advanced health technology

made possible by the generosity of Brevard residents through the Health First Foundation. July saw the opening of Brevard's first Hybrid Operating Room(OR) at Health First's Holmes Regional Medical Center. A Hybrid OR will dramatically enhance surgical treatment and this result is all thanks to years of hard work and more than \$2 million in donations and community support.

Unlike a typical operating room, a hybrid OR combines a traditional operating room with advanced imaging technology for instant accessibility to the surgical team. "The Hybrid OR provides the capabilities for physicians of different specialties to work side-by-side at the same time," said Dr. Tamim Antaki, a cardiothoracic surgeon at Health First. "Brevard County residents will have advanced technology and state-of- the-art care close to home."

Aaron Robinson, CEO, community hospitals, and service line executive for heart and vascular at Health First, assisted in bringing this technology for the residents of Brevard. "Before Health First opened the Hybrid OR we would have to travel hours for this type of technology. For those seeking help, it would cause additional stress and financial strain on the families with hotel stays and other





expenses. With the Hybrid OR here, families can rest easier knowing their loved ones are receiving high-quality, safe care down the street from where they live," Robinson said.

But this is much more than just giving a doctor a leading-edge room to perform surgeries, it is a team effort to develop and assemble experts to apply multiple technologies for the betterment of their patients. The imaging allows surgeons and cardiologists to perform procedures with advanced precision using 3D technology. Computed Tomography (CT)-level

imaging enables physicians to evaluate procedure results before leaving the Hybrid OR and potentially eliminates the need for additional diagnostic testing after surgery. Combining advanced imaging with a sterile surgical setting means surgeons, cardiologists and interventional radiologists can collaborate in real time to provide comprehensive surgical and imaging care in one place. The goal is more minimally-invasive surgeries and for patients, it could mean less pain, shorter recovery time and smaller wounds.

Creating an environment of cooperation is essential to improving the health of a community. Physicians, surgeons, technicians and administration all with the singular focus of improving Brevard County is what makes this technology possible. "This Hybrid OR will allow us to elevate cardiovascular care in Brevard County to a higher level, and will assist cardiovascular surgeons and other providers streamline their advanced, state-of-the art treatments by allowing multiple disciplines to work simultaneously." Antaki said.

Antaki says to prepare for using the hybrid OR, teams train and perform simulation surgeries together. Cath lab technologists will scrub in next to surgical technologists, while cardiologists are scrubbing in next to cardiothoracic surgeons. It's all a truly collaborative approach. "Our vascular surgeons, cardiologists, cardiac surgeons, operating room associates, cath lab associates, radiology technologists and more — all worked together on the development of the hybrid OR," Antaki added. "This was a highly collaborative effort."

Ultimately, this will improve care outcomes and benefit the community of patients, and will make Brevard County a destination for receiving national leading treatment. "The Hybrid OR offers flexibility around converting cases when necessary and will benefit the community by providing the most cutting-edge technology and advanced procedures in the region," continued Robinson. The Hybrid OR is versatile and has the capacity to also be used in thoracic and neurosurgery procedures. The imaging capabilities provide information to perform any complex surgery that will benefit from 3D imaging.

"The future of surgery is all minimally invasive," concluded Antaki. "The combination of imaging and surgical setting found in Health First's Hybrid OR will provide physicians the capability to provide complex surgeries in a minimally invasive fashion."
